DISTRICT OF LANGFORD BYLAW NO.144

A Bylaw to Amend Sanitary Sewer Utility Bylaw No. 125, 1996.

The Council of the District of Langford, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Sanitary Sewer Utility Bylaw No. 125, 1995 Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 1996."
2. Section 5.01 of Bylaw No. 125 is amended by adding section 5.01.5, as follows:

"Despite sections 5.01.1 through 5.01.4, the installation of sewer service is at the option of the owner in cases where no sewer main is installed in part of that portion of any highway on which the property of the owner abuts or in part of that portion of any statutory right-of-way that is on or abuts the property of the owner."
3. Bylaw No. 125 is further amended by replacing the period at the end of section 8.01.3 with a comma, and adding the following:

"and where section 5.01.5 applies the owner shall also pay the total actual cost to the District of extending a sewer main such that a sewer service pipe can be installed to the owner's property. [or any charge that may be applicable under section 990(5)(c) of the *Municipal Act*]."
4. Bylaw 125 is further amended by replacing section 8.01.5 with the following:
 - i) where the estimated charge is \$6,000 or less, within thirty (30) days after receipt of an invoice from the Treasurer. The invoice shall be issued after the construction of the sewer service pipe is complete.
 - ii) where the Treasurer estimates that the charge will exceed \$6,000 then the owner shall deposit with the municipality a letter of credit, cash or other suitable security equal to the estimated charge before the municipality starts construction. An invoice for the charge shall be issued after the construction


of the sewer service pipe is complete, and the security returned upon payment of the charge or applied to payment of the invoice if the owner has not paid the charge within thirty days of receiving the invoice.

READ a first time this 1st day of April, 1996.

READ a second time this 1st day of April, 1996.

READ a third time this 1st day of April, 1996.
